Lemala Mara Camp in North Serengeti moves to Mara River and guided walks introduced

From 01 June 2010 to 15 Nov 2010, Lemala Mara moves within touching distance of the Mara River in Northern Serengeti. Set under the shade of mature Eucalyptus trees, this very special site with beautiful views of the Mara River, the migration crossings and the Siria Escarpment is located in perhaps the best and most productive game viewing areas in Northern Serengeti, right amongst the migration and predator action. The camp is within easy reach of Kogatende airstrip and the spectacular Lamai Triangle. In addition, Lemala Mara will now offer guided nature walks for US\$50 per person to be booked at least a day in advance and subject to availability and min 4pax. All our 4x4 vehicles now have charging units, refrigerator with drinks, binoculars, rain flaps and of course knowledgeable guides. Off-road game viewing is permitted in this area of the Northern Serengeti.



Lemala Ewanjan moves to a spectacular spot at Makoma Hills in Central Serengeti

After considering requests from several of our clients, from 01 June to 31 Mar 2011, Lemala Ewanjan will no longer be along the Grumeti River near Ft Ikoma but will now be located inside the park at Makoma Hills in Central Serengeti, approximately 15kms from Seronera. This spectacular prime spot at the base of the hills has sweeping views of the Serengeti grasslands and breathtaking sunsets. The location means game drives can be taken in all areas of Central Serengeti and as far as Moru Kopjes and Western Serengeti. The camp will also offer guided nature walks and remain open throughout November.



Lemala Tarangire close to elephant migration route

From 01 June to 15 Nov 2010, Lemala Tarangire will be located in a secluded spot a few Kms from Kuro airstrip close to the migration path for elephants, the Silale Swamp and the Tarangire River. The camp will be approximately an hour from the main gate and will be located in the walking sector of the park. The camp will offer game walks from the camp.



Lemala Tarangire and Lemala Ewanjan - new luxury mobile tents

Both Lemala Tarangire and Ewanjan will have newly designed tents which are very spacious and have wide verandahs. Outfitted with leather beds, duvets, wooden flooring, rugs, loungers, games table, chests, wardrobes, flush loo, big safari shower and 24-hr solar lighting, they will be the most luxurious and comfortable mobile camps in Tanzania with the best locations. The mess tents too are of a different design to our current camps' and simply stunning. Combined with our personalised service, which has gone from strength to strength, there is no doubt that these two camps will prove a big hit with your clients.

Lemala Ngorongoro - Masai interaction in camp
